
Users in SAP ERP and SLcM





After chosing SAP as the most comprehensive, flexible, state of the art and future-proof solution:

2002

Successful start of the implementation of the ERP solution for the Freie Universität. Isolated legacy systems for Payroll, Finance, Controlling, and Budgeting were successfully replaced by an integrated SAP solution.

2004

SAP and Freie Universität co-found a Center of Excellence to extend the functionality offer of the SAP application in the area of study and teaching based on the module SLcM.

2006

Go Live of SLcM for course structure, module bookings and grading.

2009

Introduction of E-Procurement with electronic folder management.

2012

Implementation of a (non SAP) course planning system as replacement for three propriatory legacy systems.

2015

Implementation of CAFM-Services for floorspace management, waste accounting etc.

Migration of the SAP systems to next generation database HANA

2018

Development of an SAP-based electronic Project Application workflow (ePA)
