FUBiS at a glance

- **Intensive, academic program; sessions run in 3 terms in summer and winter**

Term I (winter): early January – late January (3 weeks)

Term II (summer): late May/early June – mid-July (6 weeks)

Term III (summer): mid-July – mid-August (4 weeks)

- **Founded in 1998**
- **Largest multi-disciplinary summer and winter university in Germany**
- **2016 in numbers:**
 - About 650 students
 - About 45 nationalities
 - More than 60 courses



FU-BEST at a glance

- **Intensive, academic program in 2 semesters of 15 weeks each**
(Fall: August – December, Spring: February – May)
- **Founded in 2005**
- **Largest semester-based study abroad program for North American students in Germany**
- **About 150-180 participants per semester**
- **95 % of participants come from U.S. universities and colleges**



FUBiS: Courses

- German language courses at five different levels of proficiency, Intensive (5 days/week) *or* Semi-intensive (3 days/week, 4 in winter)
- Subject courses in various fields, mostly taught in English
- Special: Subject course taught in Spanish in Term I

FU-BEST: Courses

- Mandatory German language instruction
- Intensive German (4 days/week, 2 levels/semester) at seven levels of proficiency *or* Beginning Experiential German (2 days/week)
- Subject courses in various fields, mostly taught in English
- NEW: German *PLUS+* package taught in German for Advanced students



FUBiS and FU-BEST: Subjects and Structures

Subject course disciplines include

History	Political Science / European Studies
Philosophy	Film and Media Studies
Sociology	Environmental Studies
Music (History)	Art History and Architecture
Business	Legal Studies
Religion / Culture	German Literature and Culture
STEM	

Maximum Class Sizes

German as foreign language: **15** students

Subject courses: **18** (FUBiS) / **20** (FU-BEST) students



FUBiS and FU-BEST: Extended classroom

- Programs use Berlin as an academic historical, cultural, and political resource
- Field trips within Berlin are an integral part of all subject and German language courses, e.g.:

- Museums
- Memorials
- Historical buildings and sites
- Political and cultural institutions
- Exhibitions
- Exclusive round-table discussions, tours and lectures



FUBiS: Cultural Program

- Optional excursions to other German cities or within Berlin (e.g. Wall tour)
- Boat trip (summer) or Karaoke (winter)
- German movie-time



FU-BEST: Cultural Program

- Students receive a semester-long pass for all State Museums in Berlin
- Two events from a choice of classical concerts, opera/ballet, and soccer
- One week-long excursion per semester to European destinations
- German Stammtisch

FUBiS and FU-BEST: Quality Assurance

- Annual course review by Academic Board, composed of tenured Freie Universität Berlin professors from various disciplines, chaired by the Vice-President for International Affairs
- Teaching Standards of Freie Universität and ECTS Credits
- Transparent Academic Regulations / Code of Conduct
- Carefully selected and thoroughly screened instructors
- Written anonymous student evaluations at the end of each semester
- Successful Completion of the *Forum on Education Abroad's* QUIP (Quality Improvement Program) in 2010 (FUBiS) and 2011 (FU-BEST)

FU-BEST: Fees

- Application & Technology Fee: 100 €
- Tuition Fee: 3,300 € (German language and 2-4 subject courses)
- Housing Fee: 2,300 € (Studio apartment or homestay)
- Program Fee: 2,000 €

Program Fee Includes:

- Freie Universität Berlin enrolment fee and Student ID
- Orientation Days, Welcome Reception & Farewell Dinner
- Public transportation pass
- Cultural program (such as week-long program excursion and local field trips)
- Semester pass for all State Museums
- Books/readers
- Official Freie Universität Berlin transcript
- Liability and Accident Insurance
