A very short introduction to the federal system of libraries in Germany

Political structure, funding and administration

Federal government: 16 states

culture and education are responsibility of individual states

- No national library law
- No central institution or government agency
- National library only established fairly recently (1912)
- No national catalogue
 - **Municipalities / local authorities** responsible for public libraries
 - **Federal States** responsible for universities and university libraries

“German National Library Act“ (2006)

function and objectives:

- acquisition
- bibliographical indexing
- long-term archiving
- making available to the public
- works published in Germany after 1913
and
- German-languages works published in other countries after 1913

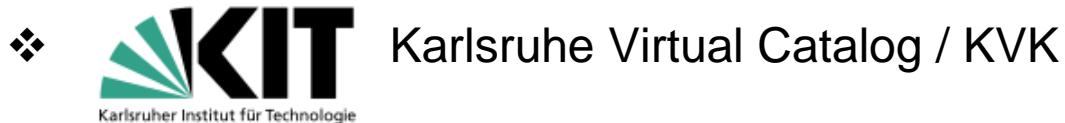
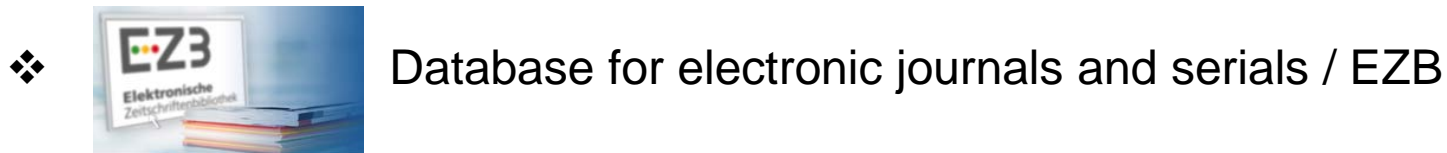
Organization of the Library System: regional library networks

6 regional networks (“Verbünde”)

- Regional interlibrary catalogues (cooperation based cataloguing)
- Interlibrary loan
- IT-services and IT-developments
- Hosting services (library systems, repositories, publications systems etc.)
- Organization of cooperations, networking and continuing vocational training

Licensing on national & regional levels

❖ National Licences

- 2004 – 2010
- completed online-databases (humanities, cultural studies)
- access: via public research organisations
- funding: 100% DFG (German Research Foundation)

❖ Alliance Licences

- 2011 – today
- current periodicals, e-books (interdisciplinary)
- access: via consortial partners
- funding: ca. 25% DFG, 75% libraries

❖ Regional consortia

Universities and University Libraries

Universities

- universities (81/113) - universities of applied sciences (105/220)
- educational federalism
- governance aspects:
 - contracts, performance measurement, funding, competition
 - no tuition fees

University Libraries

- institutions within the universities, funded by the universities
- single-tier or two-tier systems
- public service (civil servants/employees)
