6. Autumn Call for Short-term Scholarship GERSS

The German Egyptian Research Short term Scholarship GERSS is a programme jointly funded by the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research (MHESR) and the German Academic Exchange Service, Bonn (DAAD). The target groups of this programme are Egyptian researchers enrolled in MSc, PhD programmes and young Post Doctoral candidates who wish to complete their study and research with a three to six months stay at a German university. Electronic application forms can be filled out as of 1st of September till 15th of October

7. Extended Deadline: "German-Arab Research Partnerships - Al Tawasul"

German-Arab Research Partnerships provide an opportunity to extend and intensify existing research contacts between Germany and the partner countries. German universities together with Tunisian and Egyptian Alumni (usually DAAD-Alumni) can apply for funding to conduct a joint research project. This way the alumnus/the alumna can both start his/her post doc research phase in his/her home country and continue his/her research contacts to Germany. In order to build up research structures in Egypt and Tunisia and to guarantee relevant institutional effects, the alumnus/the alumna is supposed to coordinate groups of young researchers. The application deadline is **15th October 2012.** See the Call for Applications ->

8. <u>New Call of the German Egyptian Research Fund (GERF)</u>

With the aim of promoting bilateral research cooperation between the two countries in areas of mutual interest, grants are to be provided to give researchers - including young scientists - an opportunity to address new areas of scientific research. Research results generated in these projects are to be developed into concrete applications. In addition, a further aim of the joint research fund is to help scientific networks to apply for funding under the EU's 7th Research under national funding Framework Programme or schemes. The implementing agencies are the Science and Technology Development Fund (STDF) on behalf of the Ministry of Scientific Research (MSR) for the Egyptian applicants and the International Bureau on behalf of the Federal Ministry of Education and Research (BMBF) for the German applicants.
