**Université de Lorraine** (UL) is a French public university, with more than 60,000 students (18% in health, 13% in technology (undergraduate), 13% in law and economics, 13% in social sciences, 12% in humanities, 11% in engineering, 11% in science and technology, 5% management and innovation...).

UL offers trans-border European programmes within the University of the Greater Region (UniGR) with 3 German universities, 1 Belgian and 1 Luxembourg university.

UL is composed of 47 study departments, 60 research units and 8 doctoral schools.

ARWU (Shanghai) Ranking: around 200 in global ranking, specific fields of excellence (ARWU GRAS - Global Ranking on Academic Subjects): 3 fields in the world top 50, 7 in the top 100, 12 in the top 200 + specific visibility on engineering (ranked in 13 of 22 engineering subjects in GRAS).

UL is rated among the **top 3 most entrepreneurial** universities in France.



Thanks to its network of nearly 820 partner institutions of higher education in Europe and globally, Université de Lorraine has developed rich and diverse cooperation programmes and takes active part in both European and international exchange programmes, such as the European ERASMUS+ programme and the international BCI programme.

UL has set up agreements of cooperation with other international institutions of higher education to enhance student mobilty.



## STUDENT LIFE

• Health services: Free and confidential consultations, appointments and social counselling.

• Campuses: 262 buildings, distributed over 52 university sites.

• **Housing & catering**: In France, student housing and catering are managed by a public institution : the CROUS (Regional Centre for student support).

• Cultural life: Université de Lorraine proposes a particularly rich cultural offer, open to all study fields. It owns and directly manages the Theater of Saulcy, Bernard-Marie Koltès space, labelled as a «scene theatre of Contemporary writings» on the campus of the Saulcy in Metz. The university also performs events in the amphitheater Déléage on the Humanities campus in Nancy.

• **Sport activities at the University**: the SUAPS offers a pedagogic programme with more than 70 activities from beginner to expert level (online registration: <a href="https://www.suaps.univ-lorraine.fr">www.suaps.univ-lorraine.fr</a>).

• **Libraries**: 26 libraries, 5,500 seats available, 30,000 new volumes every year, 2,000 periodicals and reviews subscriptions, 7,000 students trained to desk-based research per year.

## LIVING IN METZ OR NANCY

- Accommodation & cost of living about 650 € per month.
- Located in the heart of Europe (close to Germany, Belgium, Luxembourg) at only 1h 30 from **Paris** by train.
- Student's cities: about **60,000 students** for about 300,000 inhabitants in **Nancy** and about 220,000 inhabitants in **Metz**..
