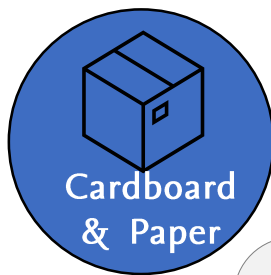
Proper disposal – be accurate!

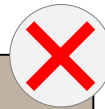
