Rules of Conduct

- o Identify yourself (please use your full name).
- Mute your microphone when you are not speaking.
- Turn your webcam on (it's more engaging).
- Use the chat function to ask a content question or to connect with your fellow attendees.
- Raise your hand if you have technical difficulties.
- Make sure no one in your location is using a lot of bandwidth.
- Use *Gallery View* when socializing.
- Use Speaker View all other times.
- The session moderator will inform you whether questions will be fielded in the Chat box or by raising your hand on video or by using the "raise hand" button found in the participant pop-out sidebar.



Some General Tips



- The workshops are held in 120-minutes live sessions, each including different speakers and room for discussion.
- The presentation format will be as follows: 10 minutes presentations + 5-10 minutes joint discussion of each session's presentations.
- o All sessions will be held via live-streaming.
- We will not record the live-sessions.

- A high-speed internet connection to your computer (preferably connected via cable instead of WIFI).
- An external webcam or built-in camera on your computer.
- A built-in microphone on your computer or for better sound quality an external microphone or a headset.

- You do not need to install Webex, just click on the link and the Webex session will open in your browser.
- Please make sure to use an up-to-date version of Firefox or Chrome.
- Don't have a microphone? Join the meeting with a phone using the teleconference number given meeting invitation.


