

Objectives and main goal

Networking through international exchange:

Creating opportunities for **master's students** to become involved in sustainability research and to network internationally.

Establishing new links between academics in sustainability-related research teams.

Research collaboration:

Future **joint research projects** are more likely to follow on such early networking.

Learning activity in the international research arena that might influence **future career** paths.

Main Goal of this internship program:

Creating an additional educational option for Una students on Master level.



Main stakeholders and role of Una Europa

Una Europa serves through MIRI as

- platform for master's students interested in sustainability-related research
- Visibility of sustainability-related research of working groups from different disciplines (more or less sustainability-focused)

Funding scheme: Erasmus+ "traineeship"

- For MIRI the Erasmus + funding scheme "traineeship" can be used
- Erasmus+ supports voluntary and compulsory internships of between 2 and 12 months
 - Internship related to the studies and intended professional activitiy
- Each student can receive Erasmus+ funding for up to 12 months per study phase (BA / MA / PhD) with the following conditions:
 - Enrollment at your university during the entire internship period
 - Knowledge of the national or working language
 - No simultaneous funding from Erasmus and other EU funding programs

Within Una Europa

- strong administrative support structures exists.
- These can help students and researchers to make such exchange as smooth and simple as possible.
